## RED WINE

### 1. Marques de Calado Tempranillo 2018

#### Spain

Ripe dark cherry and soft raspberry are complemented by cinnamon and clove spice in this medium bodied wine

### 2. Santa Rita 120 Reserva Especial Merlot 2020, Central Valley

#### Chile

Soft. Ripe. Smooth. This is a masterclass in Merlot... red-fruity ripeness which is typically Chilean, and a lovely full-but-smooth texture

### 3. Silver Ghost Cabernet Sauvignon, 2020 Central Valley

#### Chile

A medium-bodied, fruit-driven style of Cabernet that offers rounded, ripe red berry fruit with a plummy and easy-going feel. Hints of green pepper and subtle oak notes on the nose

### 4. Definition Chianti, DOCG 2016 & 2018

#### Italy

#### France

Classic Fleurie with fresh cherry fruits and a fragrant, floral perfume. Concentrated fruit and light tannic presence are testament to the cru status of this wine. An attractive wine with a silky texture
